This year our Year Two children will be performing the school Nativity Play. Year One classes will be supporting the performance by joining in with many of the songs.

Those requiring children's tickets will be given priority to attend Tuesday morning's performance. **PLEASE NOTE** children will not be able to attend on Wednesday's performances.

Each **family** will be *allowed 2 adult tickets in total*. These do not need to be for the same performance. There is no limit on the number of children's tickets for the Wednesday morning performance. If you bring a baby to the morning performance you will be expected to leave the hall should they start crying and we therefore suggest you sit towards the back.

If you attend an afternoon (2pm) performance you will be able to take your child(ren) home afterwards, however children in Years 3,4,5 and 6 will not be able to be collected early.

Please note that tickets will be allocated daily starting from Wednesday and all Year 2 applications will receive priority, so the sooner you send the form back, the more likely you are to receive your choice of performance. There will be a maximum of 90 adult tickets per performance.
