Our learning themes this term are –

Phonics Screening Check

The Year One Phonics Screening Check takes place during the week of Monday 12th June. It is therefore very important that your child is in school every day that week so they can complete it.

All Year One children will read a selection of 40 pseudo (nonsense) and real words to assess their ability to blend phonemes to decode words.
